



In 2022 and 2024, Republican delegates overwhelmingly voted to include Texas independence in the RPT Platform. Planks 20 and 203 received over 90% delegate support — more than border security, election integrity, or support of the Armed Forces. The 2024 Platform explicitly designated the referendum as a legislative priority. Yet the Texas Legislature has still refused to act.

It's time to send the message again — louder.

The resolutions in this package are designed to be carried through the entire 2026 RPT convention process: from your Precinct Convention to the Senate District Convention and all the way to the State Convention floor. Every resolution that passes at the precinct level builds pressure on legislators who have been ignoring the will of the grassroots.

IMPORTANT: The resolutions in this package are designed to stand alone. Each resolution is its own document with no numbering, no organizational branding, and no reference to the TNM. This is intentional. Present each resolution independently. Do not present them as a “package.” Do not reference the TNM when introducing them on the floor. These are *your* resolutions. You are a Republican delegate exercising your right to participate in the platform process. This cover sheet is for your reference only — do not distribute it.

WHAT WE NEED YOU TO DO

STEP 1: PRECINCT CONVENTION

Attend your Precinct Convention. The Republican Primary is March 3, 2026. Under Texas law, each County Party sets the date and location for precinct conventions. Some counties hold them on Primary Election Night after polls close; others schedule them for a later date. Check with your County Chair or your County Party's website for the exact date, time, and location of your precinct convention.

- Print at least 4 copies of each resolution you plan to present (1 for yourself, 3 for the convention secretary). Print only the resolution pages — not this cover sheet.
- When the Precinct Chair calls for resolutions, raise your hand. When recognized, state: “Mr./Madam Chairman, I move adoption of the following resolution...” and read or summarize it.
- A simple majority of those present adopts the resolution. Get elected as a delegate to the Senate District/County Convention.

STEP 2: SENATE DISTRICT / COUNTY CONVENTION (March 28, 2026)

- Attend Resolutions Committee meetings before the convention and speak in favor of these resolutions being forwarded to the full convention.
- Vote to adopt the resolutions on the convention floor. Get elected as a delegate to the State Convention.

STEP 3: RPT STATE CONVENTION (June 11–13, 2026 — George R. Brown Convention Center, Houston)

- Attend the Temporary and Permanent Platform/Resolutions Committee meetings to testify in favor of these resolutions.
- Vote to adopt these resolutions on the convention floor. Elect SREC members who support the right of Texans to vote on independence.

PRIORITY: You do not have to present all resolutions. The resolution reaffirming Planks 20 and 203 is the most important — it is the hardest for anyone to vote against because it simply asks the RPT to reaffirm its own platform. If you present only one resolution, present that one. After that, choose additional resolutions based on what resonates most in your precinct.

RESOLUTION TO RETAIN PLANK 20 & 203 IN THE PLATFORM OF THE REPUBLICAN PARTY OF TEXAS

WHEREAS, the State of Texas is founded upon principles of sovereignty and self-governance, as enshrined in Article 1, Section 1, of the Texas Constitution; and

WHEREAS, Plank 20 of the current platform articulates a steadfast commitment to these principles by recognizing the adverse impact of federal overreach on our state's rights and local self-government; and

WHEREAS, the 10th Amendment of the United States Constitution reserves to the states or to the people powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the states, underscoring the importance of state sovereignty; and

WHEREAS, Plank 20 boldly asserts that federally mandated legislation infringing upon the 10th Amendment rights of Texas should be ignored, opposed, refused, and nullified, reflecting a strong stance on the preservation of state rights; and

WHEREAS, Plank 203 of the current platform recognizes the significance of Texas' distinct status and advocates for the Texas Legislature to pass a bill requiring a referendum for Texas independence; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that Plank 20, as currently articulated: "State Sovereignty: Pursuant to Article 1, Section 1, of the Texas Constitution, the federal government has impaired our right of local self-government. Therefore, federally mandated legislation that infringes upon the 10th Amendment rights of Texas shall be ignored, opposed, refused, and nullified. Texas retains the right to secede from the United States, and the Texas Legislature should be called upon to pass a referendum consistent thereto.", represents an essential and unyielding position within our platform, affirming the rights and powers of Texas under both the Texas and United States Constitutions; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Plank 203, as currently articulated: "Texas Independence: We urge the Texas Legislature to pass a bill in its next session requiring a referendum in the next General Election for the people of Texas to determine whether or not the State of Texas should reassert its status as an independent nation." underscores the ongoing commitment to recognizing the voice of the people of Texas in determining their political, cultural, and economic affiliations and future; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that this resolution endorses the continued inclusion of Plank 20 State Sovereignty and Plank 203 Texas Independence in the platform as a testament to our unwavering commitment to state sovereignty, the rights of local self-government as articulated in

Article 1 Section 1 and 2 of the Texas Constitution, and the principles of federalism as defined by the 10th Amendment of the United States Constitution.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to the _____ Senatorial/County Convention Resolutions Committee from Precinct # _____ of the _____ County Republican Party, with the recommendation that it be passed and sent to the State Convention Platform Committee of the Republican Party of Texas.

RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF TEXAS ECONOMIC RISK MANAGEMENT

WHEREAS, Texas faces significant macroeconomic threats and fiscal vulnerabilities, including heavy reliance on federal funding, potential impacts from federal debt issues or defaults, risks of U.S. dollar devaluation or loss of reserve currency status, and dangers from economic terrorism such as cyber disruptions, supply chain attacks, or energy embargoes that could impair critical services and state operations; and

WHEREAS, systematically analyzing these threats and developing comprehensive contingency plans would safeguard Texas's financial stability, economic sovereignty, and enhance Texas's preparedness and resilience against macroeconomic uncertainties and potential federal fiscal impairments;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Republican Party of Texas urges the State of Texas to enact legislation assessing economic risk to Texas by studying federal fiscal policy impacts, currency devaluation scenarios, economic terrorism threats, and other macroeconomic risks to Texas and by enacting preparations such as mitigation plans to ensure Texas remains vigilant and self-reliant in protecting its fiscal health and sovereignty.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to the _____ Senatorial/County Convention Resolutions Committee from Precinct # _____ of the _____ County Republican Party, with the recommendation that it be passed and sent to the State Convention Platform Committee of the Republican Party of Texas.

RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF STRENGTHENING THE TEXAS STATE GUARD

WHEREAS, Article 1 Section 1 of the Texas Constitution declares that Texas is a free and independent State; and

WHEREAS, the Texas State Guard serves as a vital component of our state's defense and emergency response capabilities; and

WHEREAS, enhancing the independence, efficiency, and operational readiness of the Texas State Guard is essential to preserving Texas sovereignty and ensuring effective state-level command and control; and

WHEREAS, reforms to clarify the distinct organization, leadership structure, and authority of the Texas State Guard—separate from other military branches—would strengthen its ability to respond swiftly and effectively to threats to public safety, natural disasters, border security, and other emergencies; and

WHEREAS, such measures include enabling specialized units for crisis response, border operations, and other missions, and establishing dedicated leadership directly accountable to the Governor as commander-in-chief; now,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Republican Party of Texas urges the State of Texas to enact legislation that strengthens the Texas State Guard by establishing it as an independent entity with clear organizational structure, direct gubernatorial oversight through a qualified director, enhanced powers for missions including disaster relief and border security, thereby bolstering Texas's ability to protect its citizens and maintain sovereignty.
